- Engage with the community to identify and address health problems that affect the MCH population.
- Establish and/or actively participate in partnerships and /or coalitions to address public health issues related to the MCH population.
- Engage in activities that contribute to the development and/or modification of public health policies to promote health in the MCH population.
- Assist in district community health improvement assessment, plan, and implementation.
- Helping people understand their health condition(s) and develop strategies to improve their health and well-being.
- Helping to build understanding and social capital to support healthier behaviors and lifestyle choices.
- Deliver health information using culturally appropriate terms and concepts.
- Linking people to health care/social service resources.
- Provide informal support and follow-up as needed with clients seen in the local health centers who have a positive pregnancy test.
